

PrEP & HIV ESSENTIALS FOR PRIMARY CARE Geelong & Webinar

Pre Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) has been proven highly effective at reducing HIV transmission and there has been an increased community demand for its prescription.

General practitioners are now be able to prescribe PrEP, and community pharmacies are able to dispense it.
