### **The Dr Trevor Banks Scholarship for Palliative Care**

The Scholarship will be an annual award of up to AUD\$ 5000.00 to assist a Geelong General Practitioner to attend a national or international educational event related to Palliative Care. It is named to recognize the outstanding contribution of Dr Trevor Banks, OAM, to establishing Palliative Care in Geelong in the 1970's.

Suggested educational events for 2019 include:

- Palliative Care Australia Conference, Perth, WA, September 10-13, 2019.
- International Palliative Care and Public Health Conference, Sydney. Dates to be announced.
- Association for Palliative Medicine (UK) Supportive and Palliative Care Conference, Harrogate, UK March 21-22, 2019
- 16<sup>th</sup> World Congress of European Association for Palliative Care, Berlin, Germany May 23-25 2019
- International Congress on Palliative Care, Montreal, Canada, October 2019
- Applicants may propose other events related to Palliative Care

#### **Eligibility**

- The recipient will be a General Practitioner (GP) or GP trainee working in the Geelong region (including the Bellarine Peninsula and Surf Coast) preferably with a long-term commitment to continue to work in the region.
- Current practice should include provision of care to people with Palliative Care needs.

#### **Application Process**

Applications in writing (electronic or hard copy) should be sent to Hospice Foundation Geelong, providing:

- An up-to-date Curriculum Vitae including qualifications and current practice location
- Details of previous Palliative Care experience and current practice in the field (e.g. approximate annual number of palliative care patients, availability for home visits to Palliative Care patients and Residential Aged Care Facilities, attendance at Western Victoria PHN events)
- Preferred educational event to attend (may be subject to change)
- Anticipated benefit for GP and patients as a result of attending educational event
- Anticipated expenses – Registration fees, travel costs, accommodation, meals, etc.

#### **Follow up activities:**

After attending the event, the recipient agrees to:

- A brief summary of the event and major learning points for Hospice Foundation Geelong and Western Victoria PHN
- Attendance and brief presentation at Hospice Foundation Geelong AGM
- Attendance and brief presentation at Western Victoria PHN Palliative Care Forum in October 2019
- Confirmation of expenses and receipts where available for accounting purposes
