



EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT OF SEVERE BURNS COURSE Warrnambool - 14th April 2018



The Emergency Management of Severe Burns course is aimed at all health professionals who may find themselves having to care for an acute severely burnt patient. It will supplement existing clinical knowledge in the management of trauma patients with specific aspects and additional challenges associated with a burn injury.

The course teaches participants how to recognise, assess, stabilise and transfer the severely burnt patient.

A manual, outlining all aspects of the emergency management of burns is distributed approximately three weeks before the course.

On the day there are a brief series of lectures highlighting important aspects in the assessment and management of the acute severely burnt patient. This is reinforced by small group interactive learning with demonstrations and discussion with experts.

Assessment is via a written examination (MCQ) and a short clinical scenario utilising a simulated patient.
