2. Completion of supplementary care finder needs assessment

WVPHN will submit a one-off needs assessment that will identify local needs and inform the program development and commissioning of care finders. This will be done via a mix of quantitative data analysis and qualitative analysis. It will include a rapid consultation and co-design process with the target cohort, current suppliers, ACHs suppliers, and adjunct services that engage with this cohort.

3. Program and funding model development

WVPHN will develop the care finder program based on a sub-regional program/funding model to support the broad and disperse

cohort across the WVPHN region

These sub regions are:

- *Ballarat Goldfields (regional)
- *Geelong Otway (peri-urban and regional)
- *Great South Coast (regional)
- *Wimmera Grampians (regional)

The sub-regions of Great South Coast and Wimmera Grampians have had minimal support via the previous ACH program and the current Victorian Access and Support programs (funded by the Commonwealth Home Support Program). As such WVPHN will ensure that adequate care finder funding is allocated equitably across all areas of the WVPHN catchment.

4. Sub-regional procurement

Non-quarantined care finder funds will be allocated via an open tender commissioning process.

To alert potential suppliers to this opportunity WVPHN is undertaking broad market engagement via a marketing strategy. This is to ensure all interested parties have equal access to the opportunity and no bias is perceived in who has received this information. The Victorian PHNs are planning to collectively undertake an industry briefing to support the market in developing their proposals.

5. Integration between the health, aged care and other systems at the local level. Suppliers will be contracted to develop referral and collaborative pathways within sub-regions with a broad range of stakeholders. WVPHN will enhance integration between the health, aged care and other systems by developing a comprehensive service mapping directory. The new care finder program will be promoted to all health, aged, and community services through in the Western Victoria catchment. The WVPHN will participate in local network meetings with health service providers.

6. WVPHN will establish a localised care finder community of practice for all care finder providers. Local health providers and Aged Care providers will be invited to attend this community of practice.
